David Hall is currently the Director of Campus Recreation at Springfield College. Prior to that he was Director of Campus Recreation at The University of the Pacific, and Assistant Director of Recreation at Texas A&M University at Corpus Christi. He received his Ed.D from the University of the Pacific in 2004 in Educational Administration & Leadership and Master's degree from the University of West Florida in Sports Management in 1995.

In 2008 David chaired the building committee and oversaw the opening of the 22.5 million dollar wellness & recreation complex at Springfield College. The building was named an Outstanding Sports Facility by NIRSA and received another award for distinguished architecture by the Schools and Universities of Architectural Planners. David also was chair of the committee that built \$5 million worth of new indoor and outdoor facilities at the University of the Pacific in 2004.
